This course examines the human dimensions of environment and natural resources. We will examine major approaches to understanding human-environment issues, such as conventional environmental problem solving, environmental conflict analysis; and complex social-ecological systems thinking. Students will develop a conceptual foundation and analytical abilities needed to assess environmental governance concepts, issues, and cases associated with “wicked” problem settings.
